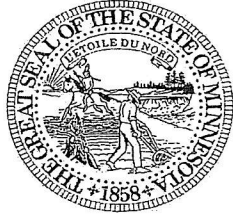

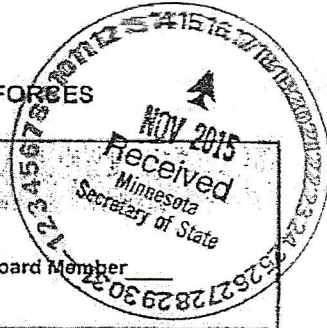

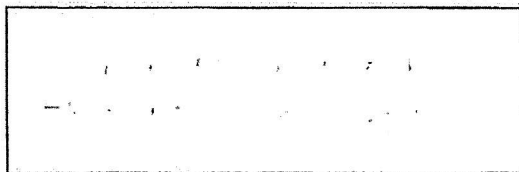
With appearances throughout the U.S., Russia,

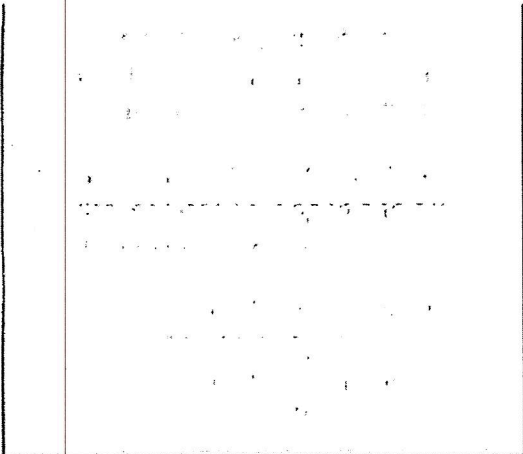

and Masters degrees and subsequently became a faculty member in the conservatory's pre-college division teaching theory and ear training. However, after graduating from

Juilliard, the realization that she had lost the joy of making music caused a complete hiatus from performing or practicing for many years. Since rediscovering the concert stage, in addition to performing around the world, she has distinguished herself by receiving top honors (First Prize, Second Prize, Music Critics Awards, Audience Favorite Performer Awards, finalist) at international competitions held in Vienna, Berlin, Paris, New York and Washington, D.C.

This 2012 McKnight Fellowship winner was greatly inspired by audiences while participating in Juilliard's Lincoln Center Program, which sends performing artists into the New York public school system, Rebecca remains committed to giving performances where classical music is not readily accessible or affordable (e.g. homeless shelters, hospitals, inner city/remote rural public schools, nursing homes, etc.). The Minnesota State Arts Board awarded her a Certificate of Merit in recognition of being an arts leader in Minnesota and in 2011 she received a Legacy Arts & Cultural Heritage Grant from Minnesota's Lake Region Arts Council to ensure continuation of these efforts.

Before moving to Minnesota, Ms. Davis produced and hosted her own classical music program on National Public Radio's KUSC in Los Angeles. In addition to performing, she gives master classes, teaches privately at her home in rural Minnesota, and will join the Board of the Lake Region Arts Council beginning September 2012.

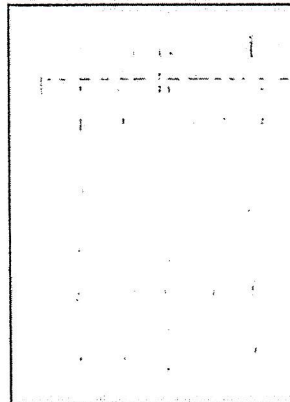

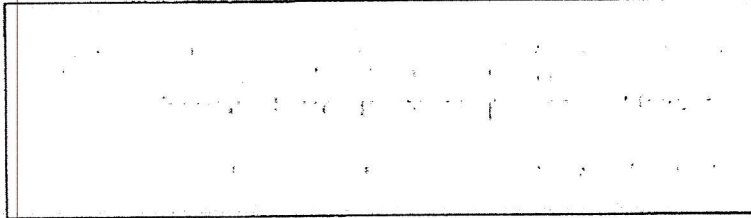

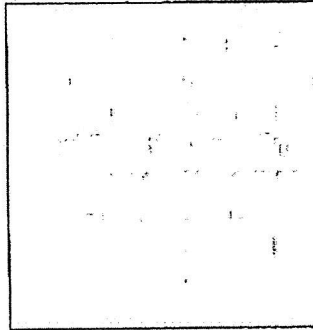
