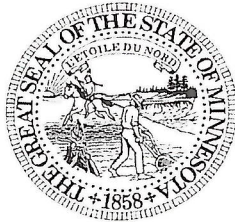

EXECUTIVE PROFILE

A seasoned manager, proven innovator and exceptional communicator have been career hallmarks. Broad public and private sector experience including expertise in government and public-private partnerships, coalition building and collaboration. Seasoned career experience in economic development, public transportation; youth development and education and media, marketing and communications.

KEY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Youth Development and Education

- Created "The Minneapolis Promise" with four areas of interest/work:
 - Built a coalition of Foundation and Business partners alongside Achieve Mpls to create a Career Center in each of the Minneapolis Public High Schools.
 - Conceived and built a coalition around the "STEP UP" program; employing over 18,000 inner city adolescents since inception in 2005. Ninety percent of participants below poverty level, 80% people of color and 50% from immigrant families.
 - Partnered with MNSCU (state college network) to create "Power of U" program which offered two years of free admission to community colleges in the metro for students who stayed at or above grade level; creating a 10% increase in number of Community College Students graduating with an Associate's Degree.
 - Created "Urban Scholars" program which prepared college students from communities of color for careers in the public sector. After graduation, they are invited into employment with the City of Minneapolis. Built 12 into city budget first year, 18 the second year and 40 this coming year.
 - Led staff conception and implantation of "I Know I Can!" program for third graders that introduced them to potential careers at an early age. The program also mobilized 1,000 volunteers to read in 3rd grades across the district. The program was later offered in Spanish and English.
- Member of Youth Coordinating Board including Board Chair roles in 2006 – 2007 and 2010 – 2011
 - This coalition of members from Park and Recreation, Minneapolis Public Library, Minneapolis Public Schools, Hennepin County and Foundation executives focused on quality out of school time including:
 - Door to door canvassing to identify and reach out to high school dropouts and invite them back.
 - Convene stakeholders from 13 city wards to align program offerings and outcomes.
 - Personally shepherded "Way to Grow" program through a critical leadership transition that saved the program's offering to the community.
- Annually visited every 9th grade classroom in Minneapolis Public Schools to initiate dialogue between the Mayor's office and students to better understand their challenges and vision for opportunity.
- Helped lobby and secure \$20M in federal funding for the Northside Achievement Zone and served on its founding board.

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Government and Public Affairs

- Government and public affairs experience as Mayor included:
 - Streamlining and refocusing of Minneapolis City Government (\$1.2B, 3,700 employees).
 - Paying off \$200M in debt, restored AAA Bond Rating and launched results-based management.
 - Reducing violent crime 40% and developed model Youth Violence Prevention strategy.
 - Leading major redevelopments, retraining of 10,000 un or underemployed residents.

Development and Transportation

- Development experience included hands-on work in public, private and non-profit sectors and overseeing:
 - Construction of \$1B football stadium.
 - Construction of \$400M 5-block mixed use development.
 - Redevelopment of second largest building in Minnesota into corporate headquarters with global market.

- Worked for two years with the Minneapolis Downtown Council doing business recruitment.
