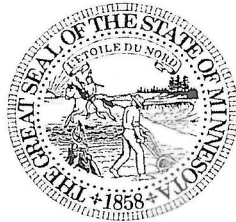

Susan Park Rani

Susan Park Rani is the CEO and founder of Rani Engineering, one of the first successful women-owned/minority-owned engineering firms in the State of Minnesota. Since 1993 Rani Engineering has won numerous accolades and honors.

Susan, was born in Seoul, Korea and immigrated to the United States at the age of eleven. The daughter of professionals, she was inspired to learn about all opportunities and industries. Susan's family legacy as a business leader began with her grandfather, Mr. Hyunwhan Park - one of the early leaders of the Korean immigrant community in the United States. Mr. Park's biggest influence was in education reform in California, in addition, to the co-founding of the Provisional Government of the Republic of Korea in Shanghai in 1919 alongside the honorable Dosan Ahn Changho. They worked closely together to help early Korean immigrants in California and for the establishment of a new government. Dosan's exhortation about self sufficiency remains at the core of her family creed and considers Dosan as their own. Inspired by the work ethic and intellectuals before her, she graduated from the University of Minnesota with a B.S. in Civil Engineering and continued her education at the Carlson School of Management to complete her M.B.A. in 1994.

After receiving her education, Susan became a registered professional engineer and created Rani Engineering. Specializing in rail signal engineering and land surveying, her accounts include international LRT project in Waterloo and Ontario, Canada, the entire METRO line in the Twin Cities, the I-35W Bridge reconstruction, and the Weisman Art Museum expansion - designed by world-renowned architect Frank Gehry. Rani Engineering has expertise in various disciplines that have gone recognized both locally and nationally.

For 24 years she has led a 45 person team, and has grown the company over 300% in less than ten years. Susan's breadth of experience in the planning, design, and construction of buildings, industrial facilities, highways, railroads, airports, waterways, and wastewater treatment plants is unmatched.

Susan is also a widely recognized and deeply respected business and community leader. In 2013 Susan was appointed by Governor Mark Dayton to serve on the distinguished, Mayo Clinic Destination Medical Center's (DMCC) eight-member board. As the largest economic development in Minnesota's history, Susan advises the City of Rochester in becoming a global medical facility. In the same year, Susan was named to the MN Host Committee for Super Bowl LII, by St. Paul Mayor, Chris Coleman. Most recently, Susan was named a trustee of the University of Minnesota Foundation, where she oversees the finance and audit committee.

In 2009 - 2015, Susan completed a six year term on the board of the directors for the Saint Paul Area Chamber of Commerce where she was instrumental in supporting the

Additionally, Susan's past civic engagements include: board member and vice president for ACEC-Minnesota, Association of Women Contractors, treasurer of Mounds Park Academy School Board, and vice president for the National Association of Minority Contractors-Upper Midwest.

As an active business and public servant, both Susan and Rani Engineering have received countless media accolades and awards, including the 2014 White House Champion of Change, where she met and was honored by President, Barack Obama. Susan was also honored as the 2013 Minnesota Transportation and ACEC Firm of the Year. She is a committed ambassador to the visibility and access for women and minorities in engineering and has mentored countless engineers and young minority business women.

Susan currently resides in Minneapolis, Minnesota with her two daughters, Sonia and Sylvia. In her rare spare time, she has taken up classical piano in the hopes to serve as the accompanist to her accomplished violinist daughter this spring.
