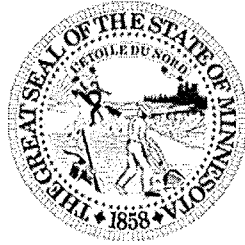

Dear Office of the Minnesota Secretary of State,

My name is Paul Drucker. I am the senior director of the Mayo Clinic Ambulance Service based in Rochester, Minnesota. I am applying for the open 'Hospital Representative' position on the Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board (EMS-RB).

I have been a registered nurse for almost 31 years and have provided nursing care in several hospitals, specifically, emergency departments over the course of my career. Over the last 21 years, I have been a flight/critical care nurse, director and now senior director. My role regularly interfaces with hospitals and the many partner practices we collaborate with along the continuum of care. I still regularly work shifts on our advanced life support ambulances.

Mayo Clinic Ambulance is affiliated with Mayo Clinic Hospital in Rochester, Minnesota and provides comprehensive Emergency Medical Services by ground and air ambulance. We also provide secondary Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) services for 15 counties in Minnesota. Mayo Clinic Ambulance is an EMS-RB approved training center and operates an accredited paramedic training program in collaboration with the Rochester Community and Technical College and the Mayo Clinic College of Medicine and Science.

Mayo Clinic Ambulance serves many communities within the eleven primary service areas where we provide advanced life support or part-time advanced life support care. Our air ambulances support hospitals and communities in Southeast and Southcentral Minnesota, Northeast Iowa, and Western Wisconsin. Our operations exist within five of the eight Minnesota EMS regions and therefore we also regularly interact with and support the great hospitals and EMS agencies within these regions.

If selected, I believe I can represent the interests of all the great people of the great state of Minnesota who deserve the best care possible. I look forward to the opportunity to serve Minnesota and ambulance services.
