I write to express my interest in serving on the Board Of Trustees Of The Minnesota State Colleges And Universities System in the Member-At-Large Position posted in the May 2, 2022 Notice of Vacancy.

My higher education experience changed my life and trajectory. As a first-generation college student, the experiences and learning I received created new opportunities and unlocked a fulfilling career. Over the last 20+ years at General Mills, I have grown to understand the complexities of large organizations and the talents required to operate across the globe. I have dedicated myself to continuing to be involved in higher education and help others have opportunities that will unlock their potential and prepare our future workforce. The pandemic has accelerated the pace of change for everyone and enhanced the need for lifelong learning.

My service in higher education started as a student leader serving as a student senator and ultimately as Vice President of the Student Body at Minnesota State University, Mankato. After graduation I served 9 years on the alumni board, including a year as president, and 9 years on the Foundation Board, including two years as chair when we undertook major transformation to evolve the board from more ceremonial to one whose members are actively engaged with good governance practices. Statewide, I have served on both the Trustee Candidate Advisory Council and the Regent Candidate Advisory Council charged with recruiting, evaluating, and recommending leaders to serve on these critical higher education governance boards for the State of Minnesota.

I am passionate about governance; I have worked hard to build my knowledge through service on non-profit boards, industry certification and hands-on experience. In addition to the higher education experience above, my significant governance experiences include current service on the Guthrie Theater Board of Directors and the Minneapolis Club Board of Governors. Key to governance success is ensuring there is clarity of roles between governance and management, selecting strong leaders and holding them accountable.
