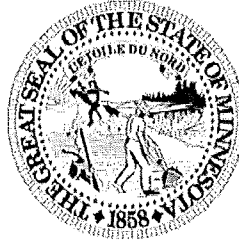

Has served, as an insurance consultant to corporations and government; as an attorney admitted to practice in Minnesota and Pennsylvania; as Chair of the Finance, Real Estate & Law Department, College of Business, Cal Poly University, Pomona, CA; as a special assistant in the Wisconsin Insurance Department and as a life insurance agent. He was legislative counsel for the Minnesota Association of Life Underwriters and Independent Insurance Agents of Minnesota. Has published in academic and professional journals and teaches courses covering risk management, insurance, and employee benefits. As a consultant to attorneys, and as an expert witness, Dr. Whitman has participated in many insurance cases and has provided in-court testimony in ten states: California, Colorado, Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, New Jersey, New Mexico, New York, South Dakota and Wisconsin.
