



statement shows, as required under Minn. Gen. R. Prac. 119.02(1), “[a] description of each item of work performed, the amount of time spent on each item of work, the identity of the lawyer or legal assistant performing the work, and the hourly rate sought for the work performed.”

3. The “hourly rate sought for the work performed” that each statement shows is, as required under Minn. Gen. R. Prac. 119.02(1), “[t]he normal hourly rate for each person for whom compensation is sought.” There is no “difference between the amount sought and the normal hourly billing rate.”

4. Each statement also shows “[a] detailed itemization of all amounts sought for disbursements or expenses, including the rate for which any disbursements are charged,” as required under Minn. Gen. R. Prac. 119.02(3). I verify that the amounts sought represent the actual cost to the firm for the disbursements sought.

5. I have reviewed the work in progress on this matter. The work was actually performed for the clients’ benefit, and was necessary for their proper representation. I have eliminated charges for any unnecessary or duplicative work.


6. A ledger history summarizing the fees, costs, and disbursements that my clients incurred in this matter accompanies this affidavit as Exhibit B. The fees incurred total \$132,636.25. (That amount excludes the fees itemized on the bill dated 05/09/2002, which fall outside the Moe Intervenors’ application; but includes the fees incurred in connection with the accompanying application for

award of attorneys' fees, which have not yet been billed.) The costs and disbursements total \$8,416.70.

7. I researched and drafted the motion, memorandum of law, and other papers in support of the Moe Intervenors' notice taxing costs and disbursements and application for award of attorneys' fees and application for award of attorneys' fees. I spent 8.00 hours performing that work. My normal hourly billing rate is \$255.

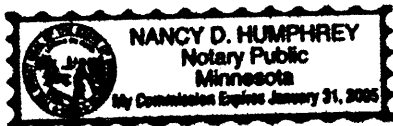


