MOTIONS AND RESOLUTIONS

Senator Krentz introduced--

Senate Resolution No. 5: A Senate resolution congratulating Ann Bancroft and Liv Arnesen on their Antarctic journey.

WHEREAS, in February 2001 Ann Bancroft and Liv Arnesen became the first women to ski across the Antarctic landmass; and

WHEREAS, they persevered against severe temperatures and treacherous conditions, and risked injury and equipment damage to complete the 1,700 mile journey; and

WHEREAS, they documented their journey on a Web site that was monitored by millions of children in 65 countries; and

WHEREAS, Ann Bancroft in 1986 became the first woman to journey by dog sled to the North Pole, and this year became the first Minesotan inducted into the National Women's Hall of Fame in Seneca Falls, New York; and

WHEREAS, in 1994, having already skied across Greenland, Liv Arnesen tackled the South Pole, successfully crossing 1,200 kilometers of ice in 50 days, solo and unassisted; and

WHEREAS, both Ann Bancroft and Liv Arnesen are former teachers who used their journey to instill in children a love of learning, exploration, discovery, and determination; and

WHEREAS, Ann Bancroft is a true homegrown hero and a worldwide ambassador for Minnesota; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the State of Minnesota that it congratulates Ann Bancroft and Liv Arnesen on their recent accomplishment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is directed to prepare an enrolled copy of this resolution, to be authenticated by his signature and that of the Chair of the Senate Rules and Administration Committee, and transmit it to Ann Bancroft and Liv Arnesen.
